
Color the pictures that explain why drinking **<u>tap water</u>** is better than **<u>bottled water</u>**.




Write a Letter to the Future I

Word Scramble II: Bottled vs Tap Water

Messages:

- Some companies sell <u>tap</u> water in plastic bottles the same water that comes from your <u>faucet</u> at home.
- <u>Bottled</u> water is not monitored and controlled by the government as tap <u>water</u>, so you can't be sure what's in it.
- All public water agencies and cities like <u>Santa Ana</u> regularly test the quality of the drinking water they provide to you.
- 4. The government requires them to test their tap water for **<u>bacteria</u>** and toxic <u>chemicals</u>.
- 5. Public water agencies give customers like you with a detailed <u>water quality report</u> each year.
- 6. Bottled water produces up to 1.5 million tons of **plastic** waste or **garbage** per year.
- Unrecycled plastic water bottles end up in our landfills, <u>streams</u>, waterways and <u>oceans</u>. It's better to drink from <u>re-usable</u> water bottles instead.
- If you were to drink 8 glasses of water a day from a Santa Ana faucet, it would cost you only 66 cents a year. But you could <u>spend</u> about \$1,475 a year by drinking that same <u>amount</u> in bottled water.
