- 1. Add this fixture, called a "low-flow aerator" [D] to bathroom and kitchen faucets [1] to slow the flow of water.
- 2. Turn off [2] the tap [F] when washing your hands or brushing your teeth.
- 3. Capture rainwater [3] from your home's roof and store it in a barrel [E] so you can later use it to water your garden.
- 4. Use mulch [4] in your garden to allow water to soak into the soil [C].
- 5. Fix [A] leaky toilets [5].
